PLE results due tomorrow

The Primary Leaving Examination (PLE) results for the year 2025 will be released tomorrow, the First Lady and Minister of Education and Sports, Mrs Janet Museveni, has confirmed.

Mrs Museveni confirmed the development yesterday after being briefed by the Uganda National Examinations Board (UNEB) on the performance of candidates ahead of the official release.

When contacted, UNEB principal public relations officer Jennifer Kalule-Musamba confirmed the development.

"It is true that the board briefed the minister on the performance of the 2025 PLE candidates, and she approved Friday as the day for the release. All details will be shared on that day," Kalule-Musamba said.

A total of 817,885 candidates registered for the 2025 PLE, compared to 797,444 candidates in 2024 – representing a 2.5% increase. The candidates were registered from 16,140 examination centres across the country. Of the total number of candidates, 389,529 were male, while 428,356 were female.

According to UNEB, 522,039 candidates (64%) were government-sponsored under the Universal Primary Education (UPE) programme, while 295,846 (36%) were privately sponsored.

UNEB also revealed that 61 candidates were inmates from Upper Prison School, Luzira. Of these, seven were female and 54 were male.
