

Construction begins on Japan-funded classroom project

Construction of a sh335m classroom block funded by the Japanese government has started at Amorigoga Primary School in Abongomola sub-county, Kwania district.

The project is supported under the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects to reduce congestion at the school.

Tukiz Construction Company was awarded the contract on January 28. The site was handed over to them on Monday.

The project includes two classroom blocks, 17 latrine stances, classroom furniture and four water tanks.

Handing over the site, Kwania district deputy internal security officer Francis Kyambadde warned against poor workmanship in the project.
