

# Security guard remanded over murder of TikTok creator

**KAMPALA:** A 22-year-old security guard has been charged and remanded to Luzira Prison over the alleged rape and murder of TikTok creator Diana Namulinde, popularly known as Diana Skyz.

The suspect, Marvin Webisa, who is attached to Gibeon Security System, appeared before the Kampala City Hall Court and was charged with three capital offences: murder, rape, and aggravated robbery.

Webisa had been deployed to pro-

vide security at an apartment complex in Kyanja-Kwata Zone, where Nam-

ulinde was found dead. He was presented before Grade One Magistrate Nicholas Aisu for the formal reading of the charges.

The court heard that under the aggravated robbery charge, Webisa and others, still at large, allegedly robbed Namulinde on February 4 in Kyanja-Kwata Zone, Kampala District. The prosecution alleges that the stolen items included an iPhone 17 Pro Max, a Samsung Galaxy A15, a power bank, AirPods, a

black laptop bag, 19 small handbags of different colours, a white suitcase, a brown suitcase, seven T-shirts, two pairs of canvas shoes, four pairs of flat shoes, 11 pairs of high heels, two pairs of boots, and a pair of purple shoes.

The State contends that the items were valued at more than Shs18 million.

“...and immediately before or immediately after the time of the said robbery, murdered the said Diana Nam-

ulinde,” the charge sheet reads in part.

Under the rape charge, the prosecution alleges that Webisa unlawfully had carnal knowledge of Namulinde without her consent on the same day.

In the third count, the State alleges that Webisa, with malice aforethought, unlawfully caused Namulinde’s death.

Namulinde’s body was recovered from her apartment. Police reportedly arrested Webisa after some of the suspected stolen items were allegedly found in his possession.

The magistrate informed the accused that the offences are capital in nature and triable only by the High Court. He was therefore not allowed to enter a plea.

Webisa was remanded to Luzira Prison until March 3 as investigations continue.

Under Ugandan law, the offences of murder, rape, and aggravated robbery carry a maximum sentence of death.

## OTHER CASES

On Saturday, Shivani Asasira, a manager of Dave Hotel and Suites, and Lawrence Musinguzi, a guard, were stabbed to death in a raid by machete-wielding gangs. Asasira was wife of Superintendent of Police Michael Akaturinda.

On November 23, 2025, criminals gunned down the Officer-in-Charge of Ntawo Police Post, Assistant Superintendent of Police Emmanuel Bagenda.

On November 6, 2025, Peter Ssekamate, a mobile money agent, was shot dead in an attack at his business in Nabuta Village, Mukono.
