According to an elaborate study of the results by *The Weekend Vision* research team, the school followed by Central College Annex Mityana, had 97.6% of the

287 candidates scoring As and Bs in compulsory subjects. The school had a total of 1,957 As and Bs. Central College had 96.7% of the 60 candidates scoring As and Bs.

The format of reporting performance at O'level has since changed in line with the lower secondary Competency-Based Curriculum. It is indicated

by achievement levels with A' representing exceptional, where a learner demonstrates an extraordinary level of competency by creatively applied the acquired knowledge and skills in real life situations. Score B represents outstanding demonstration of a high level of competency, while C' score is satisfactory demonstration of

adequate level of competency.

Schools in Wakiso and Mukono dominated in the top ten category, according to the ranking. Seeta High School, Uganda Martyrs SS Namugongo, St. Joseph's Secondary School Naggalama, Bishops Senior School Mukono Annex, Seeta High School Mukono, St. Marys Secondary School Kitende,

Seeta High School Green Campus Mukono are among those that are in the top 10.

## HOW WAS THE ANALYSIS DONE?

Patrick Uma, the Vision Group research and data manager, said the ranking was based on the average number of As and Bs per school.

"The average As and Bs gave us the proportions out of the total number of candidates," he said.
