I do not think they have the knowledge because the National Curriculum Development Centre has not developed a curriculum for them.



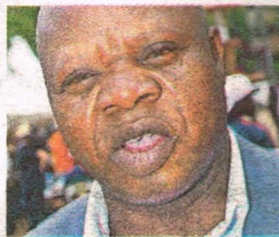
