

All set for release of A'level results today

All is set for the release of the long-awaited Senior Six examination results today. The Uganda National Examination Board (UNEB) spokesperson, Jennifer Kalule Musamba, said the officials from the education ministry and UNEB on Wednesday briefed the Minister for Education and Sports, Mrs Janet Museveni, on the outcome of the examinations ahead of the official release.

On its social media account on X (formerly Twitter), UNEB states that the 2025 Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) results will be released on Friday, March 13, 2026, at 11:00am at State House, Nakasero. UNEB says the results will be officially released by Mrs Museveni.

The release of the results was also confirmed by the education ministry on their X account.

THE NUMBERS

According to UNEB data, a total of 166,402 candidates were registered for the UACE the 2025 UACE exams compared to 141,996 in 2024 representing a 14.6% increase in candidature.

The UACE candidates wrote exams from 2,844 centres.

Of the total candidates, 42,328, representing 25%, were sponsored by the government under the Universal Post Level Education and Training (UPOLET) scheme while 124,074, representing 75%, were under private sponsorship.

In addition, 93,630, representing 56%, were male, while 77,772 (44%) were female.

The group was the last cohort of the old and non-aligned A'level curriculum.
