The Wakiso District Education Officer, Primrita Nanyanzi, has called on school leaders and stakeholders to prioritize developing genuine student talent instead of relying on ineligible players.

Speaking at the official opening of the Wakiso Zone secondary school qualifiers

at Champions Playground in Matugga, Nanyanzi emphasized the role of sports in identifying and nurturing learners' abilities.
