

Mukono ready for action

At least 6,560 students are expected to converse at Seroma Christian High School in Mukono for the forthcoming Uganda Secondary Schools Sports Association USS-SA national ball games I.

The championships slated to run from April 29 to May 9, will see athletes showcasing talents in a nine sports disciplines including; basketball 5×5 and 3x3, hockey, rugby 15s, lawn tennis, table tennis, badminton, volleyball, handball for both boys and girls and netball.

“This year, we expect the number of athletes coming for the ball games will slightly be bigger than that of last year’s games hosted in Bukedea comprehensive school, because of the few sports disciplines that have been introduced,” said USSSA Chief Executive officer, Chris Mugisha.

According to Mugisha, of the 64 schools taking part in the competition the athletes expected are 3080 girls, 2052 boys, 552 officials and 176 referees, drawing representatives from 19 zones across the country.

Seroma Christian high school was granted rights of hosting the games I competitions having won the bidding process.
