

100 Students Selected for 5th Cohort of the Equity Leaders Program

At least 100 outstanding students of the 2025 Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) have been officially enrolled for the 5th cohort of the Equity Leaders Program (ELP) bringing the total number of beneficiaries to 512.

The students now join 412 previously admitted scholars, with 81 from the inaugural cohort of 2022 graduating in different disciplines including Engineering, Statistics, Law among other fields from universities across the country.
