

Mulungi was abandoned by a mentally ill mother

On July 11, 2023, a baby boy, about two weeks old then, was dumped at Mutundwe Christian Fellowship Church in Mutundwe, a Kampala city suburb, by a mentally ill mother identified as Phionah Namuyinga, who disappeared.

The child was rescued by residents who reported the case to Nateete Police Station in the office of the child and family protection unit for further management.

Later on, the probation officer of Rubaga division transferred the child to Teresa Children's Home for protection. The child was named Walter Mulungi.

Mulungi is two years old. To help in reuniting Mulungi with her relatives, call 0704169306 or 0780247377.

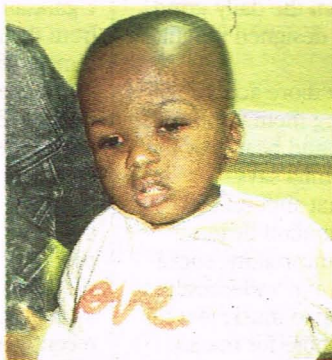
Mugyenyi has three holes in the heart

At one year old, Derrick Mugyenyi has health complications due to the challenges with his heart. Doctors said he has three holes in his heart.

The mother, Rose Basemera, a resident of Buraro village in Kyenjojo district, says her son was born normal on August 6, 2024, at Nyarukoma Health Centre III.

Later, Basemera realised that her son had failed to gain weight, was having difficulty breathing, and was crying a lot. The child was taken to Kyenjojo Hospital since his health condition was complicated; he was referred to Mulago Heart Institute, where he was diagnosed with a heart problem.

Basemera says the child needs to undergo an open heart surgery at the Uganda Heart Institute, Mulago, at a cost of sh18m before he clocking two years. To assist, contact 0786841642 or 0758970428.

Blessing was deserted by her mother

Jaliah Nansubuga, a resident of Nateete-Mabito zone, a city suburb of Kampala, says the child was deserted last year, on October 1, by her mother, who was identified as Ruth.

The matter was reported to the office of the child and family protection unit, Nateete Police Station.

Authorities failed to trace the whereabouts of her mother until the probation officer of Rubaga division, handed over the child to Teresa Children's Home for safe custody, where she was named Blessing. She is two years old.

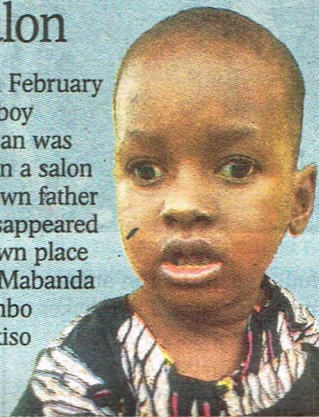
Herban was left in a salon

This year, on February 13, a young boy named Herban was abandoned in a salon by an unknown father who later disappeared to an unknown place in Matugga-Mabanda zone on Bombo Road in Wakiso district.

The child was rescued by Juma Lumu, a barber, who reported the incident to Matugga Police Station in the office of the child and family protection unit. The young boy has a disability whereby he cannot walk, stand, or eat food alone without assistance.

Later on, the probation officer of Wakiso district referred the child to Mercy Child Care Ministry for care and protection.

Where is Bisimillah's family?

Biira seeks sh30m to undergo heart surgery

Peter Masereka and Pofius Kabugho, residents of Sunga village in Masaka district, say their one-year-old daughter, Cecilia Biira, was diagnosed with a big hole in the heart.

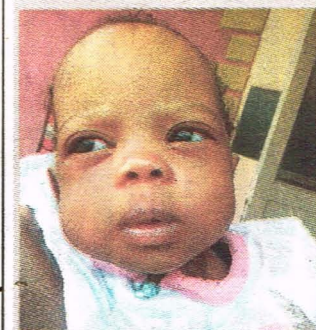
Kabugho says her daughter was born normal on April 17, last year, at Masaka Hospital. When Biira was one month old, she failed to gain weight.

"She was supposed to

be immunised, but the doctors first advised me to breastfeed her, but she just continued to lose weight and experienced shortness of breath," she says.

Biira was later diagnosed with a congenital heart defect. Doctors have recommended her to undergo open heart surgery, which costs sh30m.
